## Notes

Non-standard year-long module, this module runs across the course of the whole year to enable practice to be completed; essential; skills clusters must be passed in practice (in exceptional circumstances through simulation).

Students undertake 4 placements as part of this module and are formatively graded at the end of each one. The 4 formative grades then feed into a final summative grade at the end of the module and after all placements have been completed. The student requires a grade of 40% to pass this module.

Students have a maximum of 2 attempts to pass this practice module, no further attempts will be allowed.
