### **Outline Syllabus**

The module engages the student through practice in a chosen field of study. Drawing forms an equal integral part of practice. Students examine and evaluate the term drawing and how it forms an important element of ideas and process through their chosen field of study. Following an initial lecture on Mapping Drawing, a learning pathway is developed through digital, printmaking, ceramics or traditional Fine Art media.

A 250 word reflective report summarises the student's awareness and interpretation of the term drawing and how it has engaged as formative practice.
