Outline Syllabus

The course begins by introducing students to the notion of improvised ensemble work and utilises strategies such as focused theatre games and free form improvisation. After the improvisation section, the students then choose between the devising or storytelling routes. The devising route employs a range of methodologies which are applied in practice in groups to the creation of new work whilst storytelling focuses on the individual and places the creation and telling of a story in a historical, cultural and performative context.
