- 1. This is a research-based module with a practical designed outcome supported by a programme of tutorials, seminars, and contextual lectures.
- 2. Project proposals are informed by the students' area of interest diagnosed via PDP activities and the written assignment undertaken at the end of semester 1 for the module What?
- 3. The practical outcome is supported by studio-based activities and guidance (workshops, tutorials etc).
- 4. The final assessment for this module is 80% Artefact (comprising designed research outcome, project proposal and supporting research and development work), 15% Reflection (comprising PDP form and supporting blog). Self awareness statement is an additional 5%.
- 5. On-going informal feedback will be available via tutorial and seminar.
