Module Overview	This module will introduce the key organisational structures of museums on Merseyside to examine the changing role of museums and art galleries and explore the history and circumstances of collecting and collections.

It includes an examination of key organisations and offers on-site talks and visits. The module also incorporates development of the Work of Work Centre Self-Awareness Statement.
