The project task will comprise a presentation on their roles and the decisions they make at each stage of a project demonstrating the need to negotiate within the team in order to achieve the objectives of the project. Initial lectures will be provided to prepare them for the task followed by workshops sessions to support the students in their task. Students will also be offered formative feedback on their work during these sessions.
