#### **Module Content**

Outline Syllabus	The module will be based around five key themes: Performance: accuracy in practice e.g. rhythm and pitch; sight reading; accurate reproduction of score conventions e.g. dynamics markings, music language; communication and expression; continuity. Techniques: finger phrasing; touch; dynamics; use of pedals. Development of skills: hand coordination; rhyth pulse and meter; accuracy to score; stylistic accuracy. Practice routine: action plan; scheet theory into practice; reflection and review; feedback; working to targets. Application of Mu Theory and Listening Skills: interpretation of chord symbols and simple patterns; scales, modes and underlying chords; read sheet music; performing with accompaniment; elaborations on a given melody/rhythmic pattern; stylistic interpretation e.g. classical, jazz blues, popular music, contemporary music; creativity.
