According to specified criteria, you will critically review your creative process, the final product and your responsibility as a member of the production team. This review may be presented in an effective form, justified according to your personal process: • Blog• Vlog• Podcast• Written Analysis• Magazine ArticleYou are expected to identify areas for improvement and development in order to progress and enhance your creative skillset.
