Outline Syllabus	Songwriting lectures will explore creative conventions in popular, contemporary and commercial songwriting and will make connections to related fundamental song forms, harmonic techniques and lyric writing conventions. Songwriting seminars will explore the practical application of techniques studied within songwriting lectures and will be a forum for regular feedback and development for student songwriters. Sibelius workshops will take students from the very basic stages of using the software through to advanced techniques which will enable them to complete professional standard lead sheets. These will be supported by Sibelius drop-in classes so that students can have assistance with any issues they may incur throughout the year.
