Outline Syllabus

The module is made up of three parts

Flamenco Dance

To enhance the students physicality and expressivity and promote presence, sensuality, attack, rhythm, dynamism, power and poise they will be introduce to Flamenco dance culminating in a short performance. OLE!

Physical Theatre

Building on from the students studies in level 4 they will be introduced to the concepts and idea surrounding physical theatre. The students will experience specific workshops in the core elements which may include - movement theatre, dance-theatre, clown, mime, mask, puppetry, vaudeville and circus, which will be linked with, and followed by, a period of devising a chamber physical theatre performance. The aim of this element is not to create physical theatre specialists but to encourage actors to recognize the possibilities and potential of physicality in performance

Social and Historical Dance

Students will be introduced to a range of social and historical dance forms which, may be required of the professional actor including oTraditional Formal folk and court dance (Quadrille) oBallroom Dance (Waltz, Foxtrot, Rumba, Salsa, Tango)
