Additional Information	The NMC (2009) standards for pre-registration midwifery education requires students to be exposed to high risk pregnancies and engage with the multiprofessional team. This module is designed to support their practice.Non-standard year-long module; this module runs across the course of the whole year to enable practice to be completed, essential skills clusters must be passed in practice (in exceptional circumstances through simulation).Students undertake 3 placements as part of this module and are formatively graded at the end of each one. The 3 formative grades then feed into a final summative grade at the end of the module and after all placements have been completed. The student requires a grade of 40% to pass this module.Students have a maximum of 2 attempts to pass this practice module, no further attempts will be allowed.
