Outline Syllabus

The module aims to provide students with an informed understanding of the organisation, place and problems of film production in Europe. It investigates film production both as an industry and as an ingredient of national culture, and explores problems of incompatibility between the two. It relates aspects of European cinema both to Hollywood cinema, and to European traditions of drama and the novel. It considers whether "European Cinema" is a coherent term, or whether there is a series of disparate cinemas within Europe, and raises debates as to the future of European cinema, or the national film industries within Europe, in the new technical, economic, political and cultural conditions at the turn of the 21st century.
