Understand the main criticisms and debates over the reporting of politics in different media, including social media. Research techniques in evaluating data from specific case studies of the reporting of politics in the UK.
Module Overview	You will develop knowledge and an understanding of the structures and powers of UK national and local/regional government. The aim of the module is to be able to critically evaluate the main issues and debates in the reporting of politics in the UK.
Additional Information	Students will gain knowledge and understanding of the different structures and powers of governance affecting the UK and be able to critically evaluate the reporting of politics in a wide range of media, and the impact this reporting has on the political processes, including elections.
