| Outline Syllabus | Genetics, genomics, placentation disorders, hypertensive diseases, eclampsia, HELLP syndrome, diabetes, epilepsy, oligohydramnios, polyhydramnios, prolonged rupture of membranes (PROM), amniotic fluid embolism (AFE), Intrahepatic Cholestasis of Pregnancy (ICP), antepartum haemorrhage (APH), postpartum haemorrhage (PPH), venous thromboembolism (VTE), disseminated intravascular coagulation (DIC), sepsis/infection, role of the midwife in recognising a deviation from the norm, professional accountability, maternal adverse outcomes, exam preparation. |
