#### **Aims and Outcomes**

Aims	To develop an understanding of the personal and professional skills and attributes required for teaching and learning within PE. A continuation of the development of subject knowledge and understanding surrounding occupational socialisation (L4). Using theoretical underpinning, students will be introduced to the importance of the professionalisation phase of occupational socialisation.
