Outline Syllabus

How to teach reading in the primary school. The place of phonics in KS2. Reading comprehension and appropriate strategies for the development of this. Children's development in reading and writing. Planning for reading and writing. The writing process and elements of this. Talk for writing. Strategies for the teaching of fiction and non-fiction writing. Beginning to assess children's reading and writing.

Learning Activities

Interactive lectures which are delivered through a mixture of whole group and small group activities. There is an expectation that students will engage in independent learning and track the development of their subject knowledge in their tracking documents.
