Module Overview	This module provides you with an international perspective in relation to education policy and practice. It further encourages you to locate education within globalised social, political and economic frameworks and influence. One of the key concepts for the module is globalisation, and you are encouraged to consider the implications for education of living in a 'globalised' world. The impact of globalisation on national education systems is considered, as is the relationship between education and international development.
Additional Information	The module provides an international perspective in relation to education policy and practice. It further locates education within globalised social, political and economic frameworks. Students will be given the opportunity to consider a range of views by means of a group presentation with individual components (individual marks will be given for AS1) that scopes out a particular position related to the subject matter of the module. An In-Class Debate further allows students to develop their rhetorical skills in support of this position.
