Teaching methods on PE materials in primary and secondary school – developing effective teaching materials that are conducive for teaching primary and secondary physical education sessions. 3. Teaching theory – understanding the various theories and practices which underpin teaching, specifically linked to physical education and understanding which theory applies to them.
