Outline Syllabus	This module critically examines core issues in the field of mental disorders. These will include, for example, conditions such as depressive disorders, anxiety disorders, psychotic disorders, personality disorders and substance abuse disorders. Students will be presented with information that guides the diagnosis, explanation and various treatments for disorders such as these, with a view to providing a basis for future study and/or employment in this fascinating area.
