#### Aims

The module aims to provide a few signposts and directions to some of the many possible journeys of devising theatre. The intention is to investigate some, of the many, specific techniques that can be applied to the devising process, with the emphasis firmly placed upon playfulness, creativity and narrative. Students will be provided with basic theory and tools to approach narrative devising in a number of differing contexts/styles.

## **Outline Syllabus**

#### Phase 1

The initial phase of the module will be characterised by an in depth consideration of the notion of story and narrative. Archetypal themes will be explored and a series of practical exercises will be utilised to develop the student's own ability to analyse, construct and perform stories. In parallel students will be taught techniques to harness both personal and group creativity and explore group working methods. The phase will conclude with an improvised story telling performance for students from other year groups.

### Phase 2

In the second, longer, phase the focus will turn to the exploration of techniques used to create sustained, replicable pieces of performance in small groups. Students will form devising teams and begin creating a short piece of performance on a given stimulus. Part way through this process each team will engage in an assessed reflective tutorial with the module leader within which the students will critique their work in process and action plan steps to take their piece forward. The module concludes with an assessed presentation of each devised performance.

#### **Learning Activities**

This module is delivered through practical workshop. Students are expected to work

individually or in small groups for the purposes of practical assignments.
