### **Module Content**

Outline Syllabus	This module is common to BA performance courses. Each student will rehearse two public performance project either within our own theatre or elsewhere. The performances will be led by IAB full-time staff or external directors / choreographers / Musical Directors. These projects will represent the first opportunity the students will have of taking a production full-scale production during their studies so time will be spent with the students exploring with the process of developing a production from initial conception to full production. The exact nature / choice of each performance project will be dependent on the needs and aspirations of each particular group as considered by the module leader. In addition to performance roles students are also expected to contribute to technical and production role.
