## **Outline Syllabus**

*The Acting company module will be based around a number of simulated professional performance projects. It is anticipated that each student will have a substantial performance involvement in at least Four productions and may have lesser roles in a number of others.*

The productions will be directed by IAB full-time staff, and visiting professional directors. During the module students will be expected to bring together all their previous studies and demonstrate their capacity to apply their own personal and professional approach to performance.*
