Outline Syllabus

Showcase and Audition Material

Students will be supported and coached in the selection and preparation of a selection of audition speeches. In addition students will also participate in the creation of a performance showcase for agents and casting directors

Promotional Material

Students will be supported in the development of promotional material, including head and body shots, business cards, cv and other material for a professional portfolio.
