Module Content

Outline Syllabus	This module is designed to provide students with the opportunity to apply and develop their theoretical knowledge and applied practice skills by engaging in a group work related learning project. Learning/activity will be structured through a group learning agreement, placement activity, supervision tutorials and evaluated by the completion of a group and an individual assessment tasks. This module places significant emphasis on group tutorials with the academic placement supervisor to facilitate the student learning experience. This module contributes to the development of graduate teamwork / interpersonal and communication skills.
