Students will have a choice of either a primary research based dissertation or a literature based dissertation.

Module Content

Outline Syllabus

The dissertation provides students with the opportunity to carry out a substantive piece of research over two semesters on a topic of their own choosing drawn from the social sciences and/or health studies. This choice is made in negotiation with subject tutors.1. For most of this module, students will work independently and be expected to use the research skills and concepts introduced in levels 4 and 5 to conduct their own research.2. Supplementary research methods training relating to the research process, conduct; analysis and presentation of research findings expected within a dissertation will be provided during tutorials.
