Aims

The module provides the student with the opportunity to undertake a sustained period of professional practice within an area of music, entertainment, theatre or events that reflects their career aspirations (a minimum of 310 hours of professional

practice). The student will have the opportunity to contribute to an organisation's activities in a broad and in-depth manner over a period of months. The student will be able to gain experience and knowledge to help them gain employment or self-employment in their chosen area.

Outline Syllabus

Work placement specific. Dependent upon individual placements and negotiated learning contracts. Supported by individual LIPA tutors

Learning Activities

All students undertake a work placement consisting of a minimum of 310 hours of professional practice. The work placement is approved by the host company and by the Module leader, using a standard learning contract. Additional support is provided through:

- Workshops to facilitate preparation of learning contracts for approval
- Recorded lectures
- Mentoring & assessing the student during their time working on projects by an allocated LIPA tutor. This will be through a variety of methods including workplace visit, on-line discussions, support from workplace mentor and student evaluation.
- Individual study in line with guidance and direction from tutors
