The module will see students interpreting the evaluation and choosing the appropriate policy and tactical recommendations that the evidence assessment identifies.

Students will evaluate the evidence they have collated and produce an evaluation report and present the lessons learned and benefits. Students will also explore their communication skills by identifying the most appropriate way to communicate the outcomes to their community and internally to their force.
