Module Content

Outline Syllabus	Ballet will consolidate and refine the technical work completed in Level 5. Use of balance, alignment, spatial direction and control will increase in complexity. In Jazz, students will experience combinations that challenge them in terms of rhythm and technical demands. Understanding of the connection with a character, objective or emotion, will be paramount. Classes will focus on students as both individual artists and ensemble members. Tap will adopt a greater focus on ability to pick up choreography and employ improvisation-al skills in a structured and supportive environment. Repertoire will include traditional and contemporary musical theatre material as well as an exploration of other tap styles and advanced techniques.
