Module Content

Outline Syllabus	In Commercial classes there will be a focus on highlighting the cross-genre nature of Commercial Dance, particularly between the techniques studied in Level 5 classes. Students will develop advanced levels of technical and performance ability by interpreting more demanding choreography, complex combinations, and highly dynamic phrase work. In Commercial classes, styles studied may include but are not limited to: Hip Hop (Foundation & New Style) Funk styles, Vogue/Fem and Commercial-Jazz, Freestyle and Heels techniques.In Jazz classes the focus continues to be on improving the students' adaptability and versatility by advancing the difficulty of technical exercises and choreographies learnt in class. Previously studied styles will be covered again with a higher level shown in technique, technical accuracy, creativity, expression, artistry, professional practice and pick up skills. The synthesis of each of these aspects will be judges within performance. Other styles and new emerging trends will also be explored.
