Module Content

Outline Syllabus	This module is primarily undertaken by the student in the form of fieldwork, data analysis and project write-up. However, students are encouraged to maintain regular contact with their supervisor. Ideally students are encouraged to see their supervisor fortnightly.
Module Overview	This module provides the opportunity to gain practical experience of empirical research. You will gain a deeper understanding of conceptual, methodological and logistical problems that may be encountered when conducting research.
Additional Information	Students will design and conduct a significant piece of research in the field of Positive Psychology. A major aspect of the development of any research project is to structure research ideas within an acceptable framework that may be subjected to peer review. After formulation of initial research ideas, students are encouraged to discuss these with their supervisor and to agree a plan of action before the research commences. This will involve seeking ethical approval.
