Module Overview

help you plan, organise and deliver a final published project or equivalent, through effective time and resource management, demonstrating a high level of critical engagement, creative achievement and appropriate technical ability

develop your ability to present your work and enhance your capacity to engage in professional practice

Additional Information

This is the module where students bring together all the skills they have acquired on the programme demonstrated by public outcome or equivalent. Students will be required to make a working proposal (including an abstract and details about how the project will be disseminated) about which they will receive feedback and support in its realisation from academic staff. Students will be assessed by a public-facing outcome from a significant body of work, including evidence of reflection and supporting work.
