Outline Syllabus

This module centres on a critical examination of current issues in education from the perspective of the critical, reflective professional. A major current issue is identified as a case study for critical examination of the nature of policy and policy implementation on professional practice. Participants will work to develop a critique of the identified area of interest.

They will:

- -Identify an aspect of their practice they wish to investigate and develop
- In consultation with their tutor identify related literature, drawing on this to analyse key issues
- Examine professional practice in the light of the critique of literature/research/policy

Learning Activities

This is an independent study style module. It involves supported individual exploration of a chosen current educational issue, self study and practitioner enquiry
