Additional Information	This module focuses on the teaching placement (minimum 120 days) in a Home School and Alternate Placement, including the tracking and recording of mentoring and progress against the Teachers' Standards. To pass the module and meet the competency requirements, trainees must pass the placement experience and triangulation process, with evidence of progress recorded in the LJMU ITT Tracker, QTS Training and Development File and Placement Experience Files. Trainees must also complete a Career Entry and Development Profile (CEDP) outlining targets for early career development.
