Aims	The module enables students to investigate in depth a topic within the field of counter-terrorism studies. Students can select their own research area, but this is subject to authorisation of the course leader. The dissertation must include independent and original research. Students will be required to submit a formal dissertation plan. Once this has been approved, students will be allocated a dissertation tutor, and for the remainder of the module, supervision of the dissertation will be conducted on an individual basis. It is expected that pertinent knowledge and skills gained in other course modules will be reflected in the dissertation.
