Module Content

Outline Syllabus	The module will consider critical ideas and public policy and their relationship to the individual practices of the students. Students will be asked to undertake self-reflection and career analysis and determine key questions that will inform their development and understanding of their craft. A range of practice research and other research methodologies will be considered and the design of research will be investigated before student propose approaches to the investigations within their final practice project. The module then provides the opportunity for a student to propose and deliver a creative practice project which addresses professional priorities identified through careful self-reflection and critical analysis. The project is individually supervised.
