Module Content

Outline Syllabus	VoiceThrough this module, the student will build on their prior understanding of the actors voice and enhance its use for theatre and performance. A particular focus will be on ensuring safe and sustainable practice. Students will explore posture, breathing, alignment, relaxation, rhythm and the development of resonance. The students will be asked to explore the poetic and rhetorical devices of complex, and heightened texts, discovering vocal processes and methods to develop clarity, expression and character influenced by Linklater, Estill, Berry and Fitzmaurice techniques. MovementThrough this module students will explore the physicality of performance. Initially students will explore correct alignment, placement and core stability. Building on from this, the student will start to explore the creative potential of the actor to tell story and enhance character through movement. Students will be introduced to Laban movement techniques and animal studies. The movement element of the module will conclude with a short staff led physical movement based chamber performance
