These seminars will be supported by eight lectures on contemporary urban issues and the outputs will feed into the group urban strategy in module 7523ARSRI.Output 2: Thesis theory and ResearchTo provide the opportunity to identify and research an area of architectural theory which will inform the design component of module 7524ARSRI.
