### **Outline Syllabus**

Working in conjunction with the supervising tutor, the student will identify the precise area to be researched. Building on the Research Methods in Management module, students will develop and apply critical researcher skills, both with regard to methodological justification and subject specific issues.

#### **Learning Activities**

Students will be allocated a suitably qualified member of staff who will supervise the dissertation. Students will maintain contact with their supervisor on a regular basis. The agenda for each encounter will vary according to the needs of each student and the subject area being studied.

#### **Notes**

The dissertation builds on previous learning from Research Methods in Management and appropriate subject specific modules, with the learning outcomes being achieved through a 20,000 word dissertation that applies concepts and research techniques to critically investigate an organisational issue or problem. The expectation is that for this advanced, in-depth study, students will be capable of operating as independent critical thinkers, although appropriate developmental support will be provided through a designated supervisor.
