Additional Information	The programme offers Midwives the opportunity to enhance their skills sets and knowledge in terms of High dependency cases. A varied range of conditions will be covered in depth, which will increase knowledge and application to maternity cases. Evidence based practice and guidelines form an integral part of teaching, and encourage critical review and reflection of standards of care and clinical management. The programme has two essential elements divided into theory and practice. Both theory and practice must be passed to successfully complete the programme. The practice aspect of the programme involves experience in a relevant area and this is reflected within the associated documentation. The practice aspect of the Frameworks for Higher Education Qualifications of UK Degree-Awarding Bodies (FHEQ) and is aligned to level 7 descriptors. The module is part time with a written assessment submission of an essay.3. The criteria for admission to the module require that candidates are currently working/engaging with a critical high dependency setting.4. The final award is a Continuing Professional Development – Complex High Dependency Maternity Care5. The students will have access to a VLE site and the University's other range of electronic support such as access to the electronic library facilities. The module VLE site also includes a number of presentations for students to access on areas such as critical writing and library support.
